ABC (Accelerated Boot Camp) Toolbox Construction Trades Academy

Located on the Arrak Campus of the College of the Marshall Islands

Job Title: ABC Toolbox Instructor

General Description:

You will train up to 50, Marshallese young adults, ages 18-24, in basic construction trades. The ten-week, 24/7, 300+ hour total training program will be on the Arrak campus. You will provide classroom instruction in trade methods, care and handling of hand and power tools, safety practices, and will also be responsible for creating and maintaining a “sprit de corps” among a smaller group of trainees. You will be required to maintain a safe, clean, and orderly teaching and learning area and be a positive role model demonstrating employability and life skills. You must be of good moral character and able to speak Marshallese and fluent English. You must pass a background investigation; and pass a trainer examination after participating in a four-day “train the trainer” pre-service program. You will be expected to assess and evaluate each trainee’s weekly progress and provide a summative report on each trainee’s basic core curriculum mastery of construction trades learning outcomes, and perform other duties as assigned, including some evening and week-end Academy activities.

Minimum Requirements:

Five years successful work experience in the identified construction trades area(s); **and/or** an equivalent combination of experience and training equal to five years; experience working with young adults; valid RMI driver’s license; be able to speak Marshallese and be fluent in English; and successfully pass the trainer’s examination following a four-day pre-service training program.
